TREE REMOVAL DAREBIN COUNCIL REGULATIONS



Can I remove a tree in Darebin Council without a council permit?

Yes, but under certain conditions

Under what conditions?

A permit is required to remove, destroy or lop any vegetation that is in Darebin's Vegetation Protection Overlay (VPO)


Are there exemptions?

Yes, this does not apply:

- If the vegetation has been planted for pasture, timber production or any other crop.
- To any action which is necessary to keep the whole or any part of any vegetation clear of an electric line provided the action is carried out in accordance with a code of practice prepared under Part 8 of the Electricity Safety Act 1998.
- Within electricity supply easements in order to minimise the risk of bushfire ignition in the proximity of electricity lines.
- If the vegetation presents an immediate risk of personal injury or damage to property.



- If the removal, destruction or lopping of vegetation is necessary for emergency access or emergency works by a public authority or municipal council.
- For fire fighting measures, periodic fuel reduction burning, or the making of firebreaks up to 6 metres wide.
- If the removal, destruction or lopping of native vegetation is necessary for the making of a fuelbreak by or on behalf of a public authority in accordance with a strategic fuelbreak plan approved by the Secretary of the Department of Sustainability and Environment.
- The maximum width of a fuelbreak must not exceed 40 metres.
- To the removal of ground fuel within 30 metres of a building.
- If the removal, destruction or lopping of vegetation is in accordance with a fire
- To the removal, destruction or lopping of the minimum extent of vegetation necessary for establishing sight-lines for the measurement of land by surveyors in the exercise of their profession, and if using hand held tools.
- If the vegetation is proclaimed as a noxious weed or is bracken (Pteridium esculentum), burgan (Kunzea ericoides (previously Leptospermum phylicoides)) or manuka (Leptospermum scoparium) and is on land which




