# TREE REMOVAL REGULATIONS

## Can I remove a tree without a council permit?

Yes, but under certain conditions

## Under what conditions?

A landowner can now remove any tree or vegetation on a residential property (less than 1500m<sup>2</sup>) without an application to Council, UNLESS the tree is a protected species or the property is heritage listed.

## What about Pruning?

Trees on private land throughout the shire may be pruned without the prior written consent of Council if pruning is carried out in accordance with the Australian Standard.

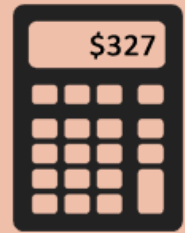
